1. To comply with relevant legislation and other environmental requirements to which the Division subscribes.
2. The minimisation of resource use and waste generation.
3. Effective liaison with internal and external interested parties.
4. Provision of environmental training for key staff.
5. Prevention of pollution.
6. To maintain an Environmental Management System which identifies and controls those company activities which impact upon the environment.
7. Continual improvement in company environmental performance through the setting of targets.
8. To regularly assess environmental aspects and develop programmes for the improvement of those aspects found to be significant.

All activities at the Environmental Division's sites will comply with the requirements of BS EN ISO 14001 : 2004. This policy is fully consistent with the company's health & safety policy, quality policy and business plan.
